NAMING OPPORTUNITIES: *(Example of naming opportunities may vary depending on each community's needs.)*

There are a number of opportunities for honoring or memorializing individuals for recognition of corporate and foundation support. An appropriate plaque or signage at the field will denote specific major support of the facility.

- Title Sponsor for Baseball Field**\$500,000
It is on this field that the at-risk youth of Baltimore will play ball and begin to learn positive life skills to help lift them to more rewarding and productive lives. Prominent signage will be displayed on the field.
- Scoreboard**\$250,000
Teaching kids about teamwork is a vital lesson of the Cal Ripken, Sr. Foundation. The scoreboard will offer a place for top recognition to community supporters.
- Outfield Fence**\$150,000
This space provides an opportunity to highlight your support to all who visit the ballpark.
- Character Building Track**\$100,000
The track that circles the playing field is an integral part of teaching youth valuable life lessons and offers a place where the community can get involved and get healthy.
- Picnic Pavilion**\$50,000
This shelter with picnic tables encourages family time.
- Recognition Kiosk with Bust of Cal Ripken, Sr.**\$50,000
This free-standing, brick recognition kiosk will hold the plaques of names of special donors to the project.
- Dugout**\$25,000 each
Coaches and young teammates will call these dugouts home during games. The dugouts will serve as places to cheer, receive coaching, and build closer friendships.
- Character Station**\$10,000 each
The stations will contain clear messages about good character that the young people will be encouraged to learn and apply to their own lives.
- Bleacher**\$10,000 each
Fans of all ages will gather to cheer on their family members and teams – and build community bonds.
